

# Many possibilities


- extra variable



## vario pro pick-up switch - assembly device



### **Transport position (switch off):**




Place the **switch** in the **flat steel bar**. Fasten the flat steel bar (e. g. initially using a screw clamp) to the stationary frame so that the magnetic switch is close to the lower edge of the movable pick-up arm.

**ATTENTION:** The temporary attachment must be at least 1.5 cm away from the centre of gravity of the flat steel bar!

Now attach the bottom magnet to the movable pick-up arm, approx. 3 - 4 cm above the switch, and the other two magnets above it at a small distance.

### Working position (switch on):



Check whether the switch is at the same height as the magnets, readjust if necessary.

If the switch is in the area of the magnets in the working position and clearly outside in the transport position (test the switch function if necessary), mark the positions of the switch and magnets.

Screw or weld on the flat steel bar (welding **WITHOUT** the switch inserted!).

Attach the magnets using the countersunk screws supplied. ATTENTION: The south pole of the magnets (S) **MUST** be visible!

Readjust the distance between the switch and the magnets – there should be a gap of 1 - 2 cm between the front of the switch and the magnets. Tighten the screw nuts moderately.

Notes: Only for load voltage 12 or 14 V DC up to 6 W, degree of protection IP 65
